Precautions

- Members of high-risk populations (e.g. over 65, medical conditions, heart, or lung vulnerabilities, etc.) are encouraged to worship virtually.
- All in attendance do so at their own risk.
- A familiarization video will be available in the weekly “Blast” and on the church website.

What’s Different

- Bulletins will not be provided when you enter the Sanctuary.
- Every other row of pews will be roped off.
- Offering plates will be located by the usher station upon exit. The traditional “plate” offering will not occur.
- Indoor Fellowship hour is cancelled until further notice, though outdoor events may be scheduled.
- There will be no nursery care until further notice.
- There will be no congregational singing, {however, we encourage all to reflect on the words of the hymns}.
- The Passing of the Peace will not occur until further notice.
- Joys and Concerns will be voiced without a microphone.
- Communion will be via modified intinction (see “Welcome Back” video)
- The pews will be released by the pastor, and we will not have a receiving line of greeters after the service.

Worship Attendance Procedures/Protocols

- Only the church main doors will be open. Please maintain 6ft distancing as you approach the church and throughout your stay.
- Mask wear is mandatory. It is best to have your mask on before approaching the front door. If you forget your mask, one will be provided (required if 2 years old or older).
- All entrances at the rear of the sanctuary will remain open throughout the service.
- Hand sanitizer is available inside the front door and to your right when entering the sanctuary main doors. Please sanitize your hands before or upon entering the building.
- If desired, please print a bulletin at home and bring it with you.
- An usher will be available to assist with seating should distancing become difficult. Extra seating will be available against the sanctuary side walls.
- “Overflow” seating will be available in Fellowship Hall and a monitor will be set up for viewing the service.
- In order to maintain distancing, please adhere to one person at a time in each restroom. Please wait outside the door, as necessary.
- After the service, please continue to maintain Social Distance and do not remove your mask until you have left the building.

Church Cleanliness Precautions

- In addition to weekly unoccupied sanctuary cleaning, on each Saturday the lavatories and common touch areas are wiped down by the custodian with the appropriate technique for the cleaning product used. The custodian leaves the doors open.
